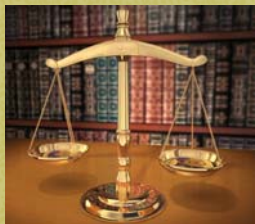

New Amendments to New York State Labor Law

Effective April 12, 2011, the New York Labor Law increases its employee notification and recordkeeping requirements and strengthens sanctions against employers who fail to pay their employees properly.

Section 195 of the Labor Law previously required employers to provide each new employee with written notice of his or her rate of pay, regular pay day, and, if non-exempt, the regular hourly rate of pay and overtime rate of pay. Section 195 now requires employers to provide written notices not only to employees upon hire, but also to all existing employees no later than February 1, 2012 and every year thereafter.
